TASTE WITH THE WINEMAKERS - \$50
Meet with our winemaking team to discuss which varietals you're interested in. Once you've decided, you can move forward with bottling OR add on a blending session. This $\$ 50$ tasting fee is credited to your deposit. Once you decide on your barrel, $50 \%$ of your total payment is due.

## BLENDING SESSION - \$20 PER PERSON

## BOTTLING

Final payment is due at this time. You will work with the winemaking team to bottle and label your finished wine! This is also when you will be able to take your wine home with you.
